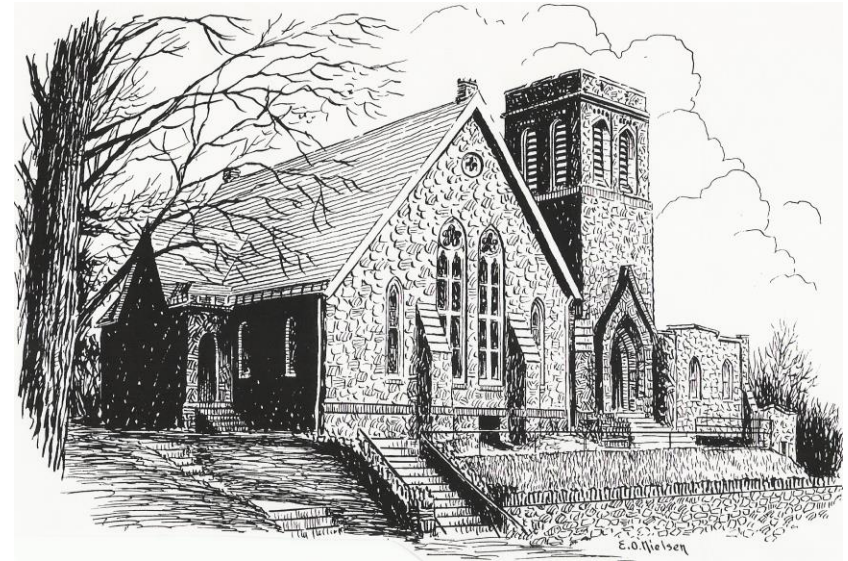
## FOURTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST
